1. Speaker to renew Portland Teachers Levy- Otto Schell, PTA lobbyist

There is a vote to pass the teachers lobby. This levy, if passed, would maintain 20% of the teaching staff- this levy funds 20% of staffing currently. It is a 5 year levy. It is the 1 thing that makes up for the state's lack of funding. First passed in 2007. Usually a May/Spring Ballot. https://renewteacherslevy.com/ Need to make sure parents are aware and support the initiative and fill out their ballots! Audience asked to tell everyone we know about the levy.

Laura Kurtz makes a motion to support the portland teachers levy. Courtney Savoie seconds. Unanimous vote in support.

- 2. Kim Stockstab (school social worker) talks about survey, last year only 53 responses only for James John. Big project for climate team this year is parent outreach to get more responses. Created google survey earlier in the year to get ahead of it. BIG ASK-Successful School survey comes out May 6th to end of May. PTA is asked to start putting that bug in everyone's ear that the survey is coming. Survey is so important for the climate team and use the results to plot out how to improve the school.
- We have an opening for Fundraising Committee. Job description:open in terms of creativity- restaurant nights and can drives (changes in bottle drop program made it easier to drop off at Safeway)
- 4. We would like to get more volunteers in classrooms next year. We see a need for that. Perhaps a signup genius- talk to teachers to see what they are looking for and help to coordinate that. Background check lasts for 3 years, you can get a hold of Nicole at the front office to check your status or do a check.
- 5. May 31st- carnival. We need volunteers to organize.
- 6. Pick up and drop off are a messy part of day. We are working with PBOT to make some streets one-way because of safety issues with this. It is very unsafe currently.
